Why choose Castledockrell National School?

We are a small school and we will always be a small school; the benefits to which are plenty:

- Transition from Pre-school The school has a familial feel, with children of different ages working and playing together, just like at home.
- **Favourable Pupil Teacher Ratio** High achievement across all areas, including academic, for all pupils.

Unique Advantages of Castledockrell National School:

- All junior infants get free books and materials for their first year; reduced costs thereafter for all pupils and no voluntary contribution sought.
- Infant classes are allowed to remain in school from 1.40-2.40pm under teacher supervision, free of charge.
- Early drop off facility for parents. Option of after-school pick up from local creche (numbers dependent)
- Large, safe playground and pitch for all children.
- All children are involved in school initiatives including Green Schools, Active Flag,
 Digital School of Distinction, and Junior Entrepreneur Programme.
- All children learn tin whistle and a variety of other instruments from junior infants up in school. Our Music Teacher also provides after-school music classes.
- Emphasis is placed on sport throughout the year; GAA, Zumba, Tag Rugby, Athletics, Rounders, Rackard League and the highlight is our annual Sports Day.
